- Understand sensory issues and their impact on mealtimes and eating
- Support students to explore different foods by tasting
- Clarify information to students and explain the effects of nutrients on overall health condition
- Suggest positive alterations in nutrition to address students' dietary restrictions
- Create full and personalised nutrition plans that promote healthy lifestyles
- Set clear objectives and provide support to students to help them in their progress
