This Pathway focuses on developing students' personal, independence and employability skills with functional skills embedded within the study programme. Attending work experience placements up to two times per week to continue to develop on skills that have been learned in the classroom.

Work Experience

Take skills learned in the classroom into a work environment and continue to develop in an identified, aspirational area of work while being supported one to one or as part of a small group.



Job skills

Learning in the classroom about the skills that will be needed to make the transition into a workplace environment a safe and successful experience.



Independence

Skills are developed through Independent Living sessions in the classroom and in our ILS house. Pathway Travel Training and a bespoke PSD curriculum also promote our students' independence.
