Become confident in your ability to work and watch as you grow to be a valued member of the team. Continue to develop your social and emotional skills as build relationships with peers and staff from your host business.

How Does It Work?

- One year supported internship training programme
- Rotate through three different areas and skills
- Work towards entry 3 award in employability and development skills
- Celebrate with the end of course Graduation.
