Participate in an immersive internship on site at your host business for 5 days per week (Monday-Friday). Develop key skills needed to be safe and successful in a live working environment. Become confident in your ability to work and watch as you grow to be a valued member of the team. Continue to develop your social and emotional skills as you build relationships with peers and staff from your host business.



How Does It Work?

- One year supported internship training programme
- Rotate through three different areas and skills
- Work towards entry 3 award in employability and development skills
- Celebrate with the end of course Graduation.

What Job Roles Are At ICB?

Clerical: Filing, data entry, other computer skills, phones, reception, meet and greet, information desk, digital scanning, coding, **Care**: Personal care, personal support, **Grounds**: Mowing, strimming, planting, **Maintenance**: PAT testing, painting, changing light bulbs, changing filters, fridges - temperature checking, waste management, **Retail**: Till work, fronting shelves, expiration date, **Stores**: Receiving, delivery, stocking, post room, **Catering**: hospitality (fridge stocking), meeting room set up, food handling (meal preparation, meal delivery), **Domestics**: Sanitary dispensers/infection control, floors, window cleaning, laundry, **Warehouse & Logistics**: Work in a warehouse environment to develop safe logistical working safe logistical working
